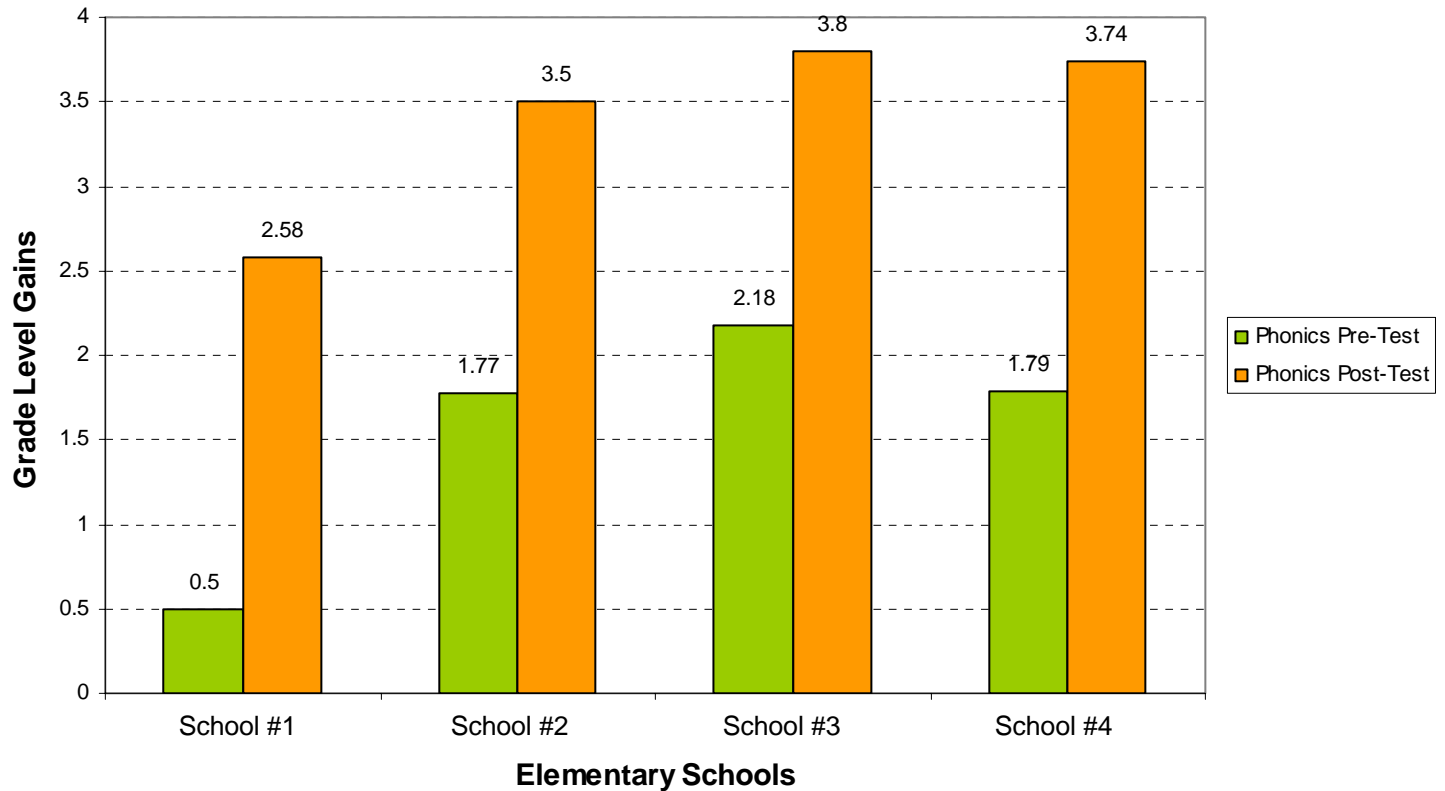

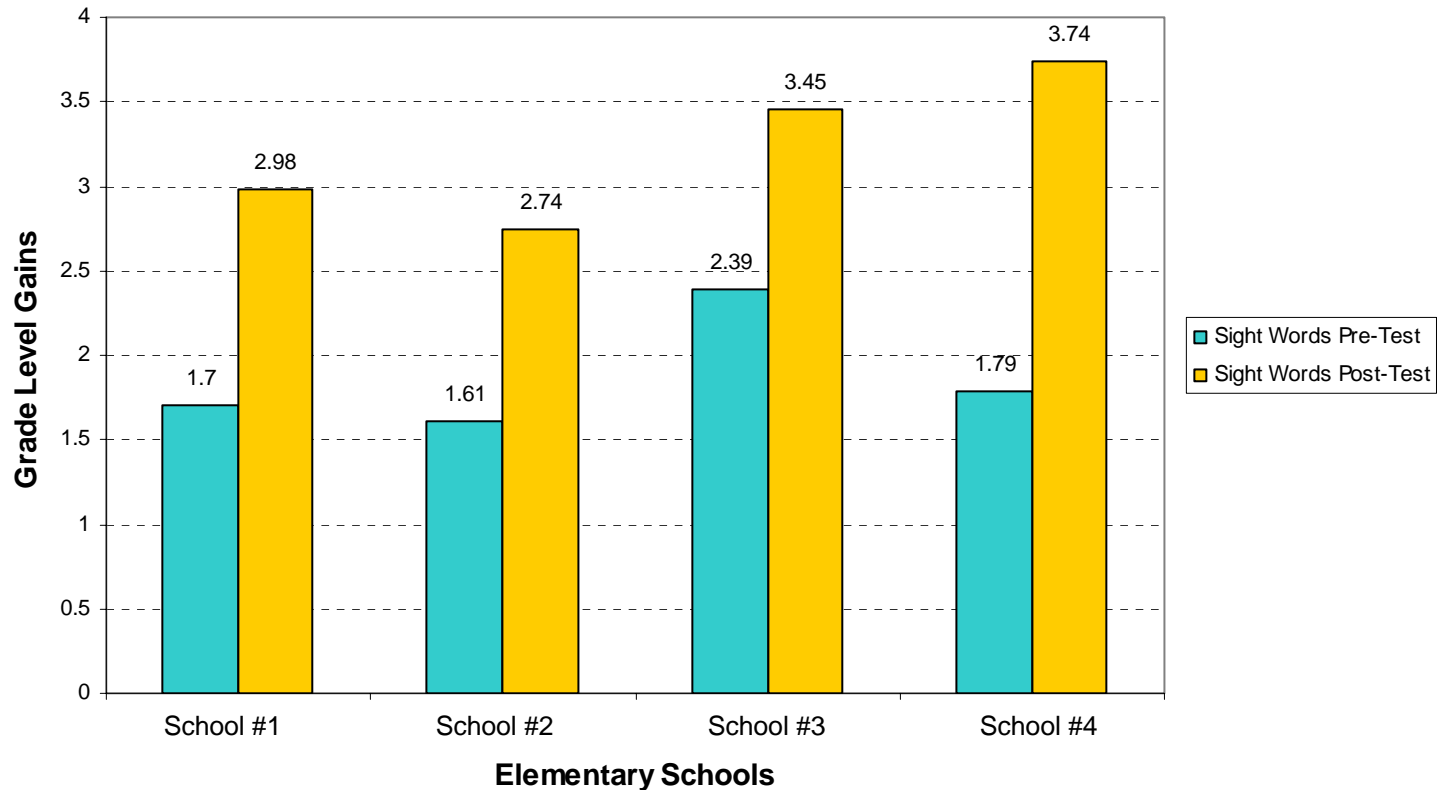
Phonics Gains 2004-2005

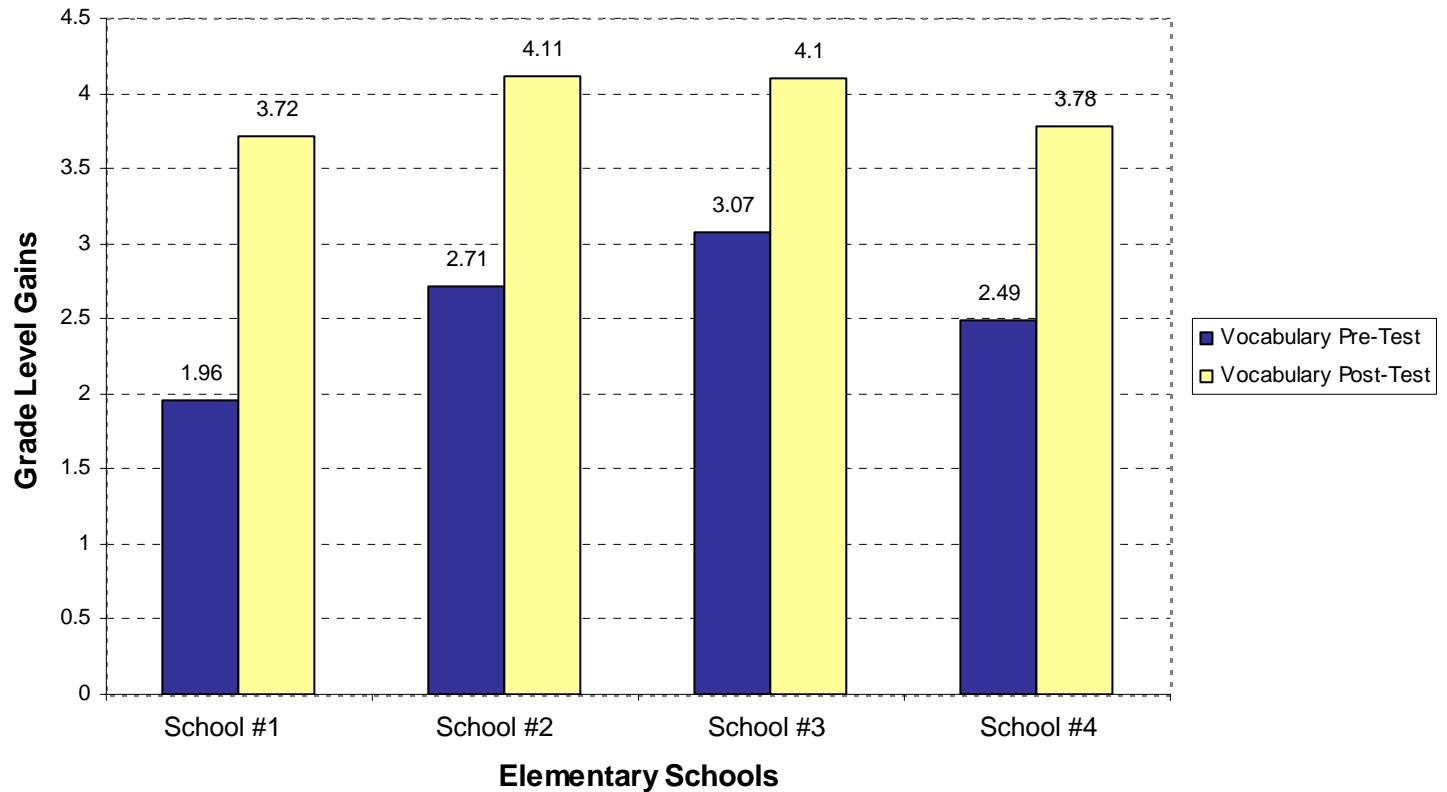
Reading Gains – Sight Words

Sight Words Gains - 2004-2005



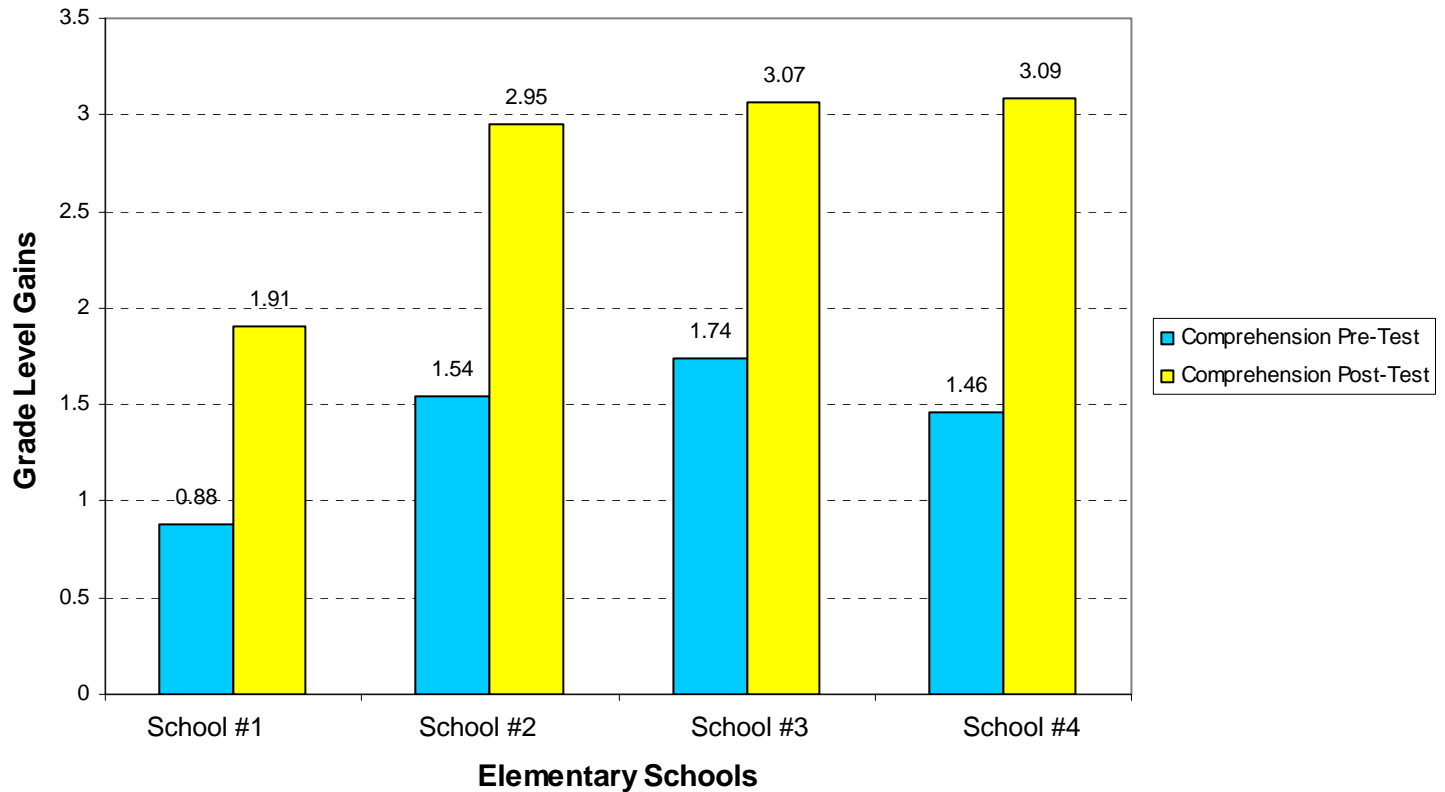
Reading Gains - Vocabulary
